





The 1.4 gigawatt (GW) Interconnector will provide an electricity transmission link between Scotland and Norway.

Electricity can be transmitted in either direction across the North Sea.

The Converter Station is proposed for the 'Fourfields' site west of Stirling Hill Quarry. The AC cables will run underground to connect to a new extension proposed for the Peterhead Sub-Station site near to the Power Station.

The concept design and main findings of the Environmental Impact Assessment of the proposed development will be presented at the session.
